PART II (Situation description)

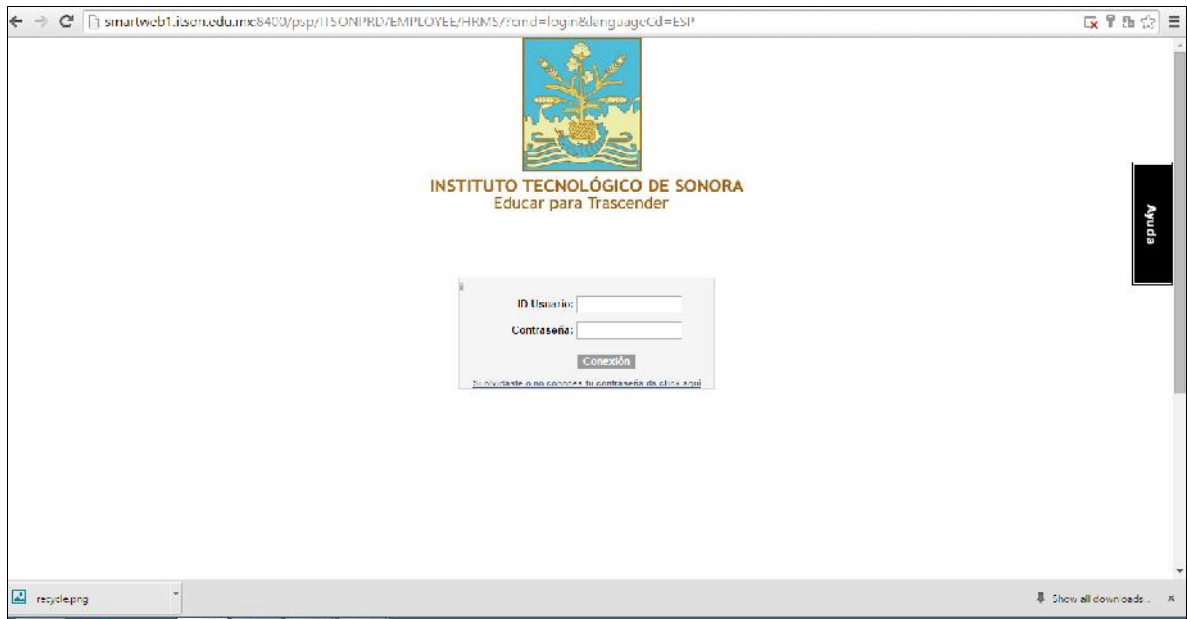
- Task
