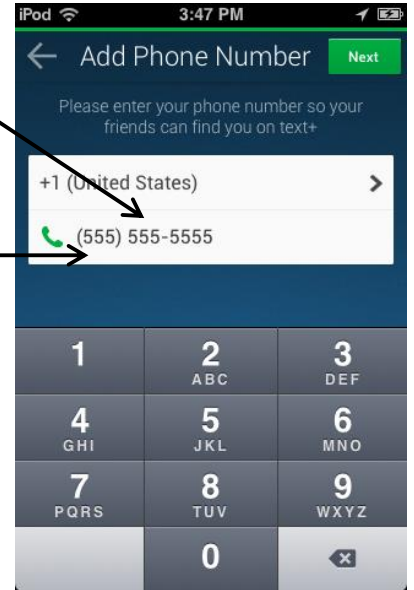

AREA CODE: (555)

### SAYING TELEPHONE (PHONE) NUMBERS

- We say the area code + the number as singles digits

e.g. **(644) 413-9465**

**We say:**

*Area code six-four-four and the number is four-one-three-nine-four-six-five.*

- When a 0 (zero) is in a phone number, we pronounce it "OH" (the letter from the alphabet)

e.g. **(213) 773-6075**

**We say:**

*Area code two-one-three and the number is seven-seven-three-six-oh-seven-five*

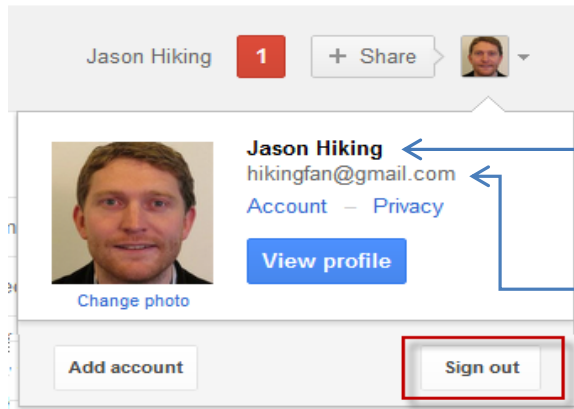

- **@:** In English we say **AT** for the “arroba” symbol. In Spanish we say “arroba”
- **.com:** In English we say **DOT COM**
- **\_:** In English we say **UNDERSCORE**
- **---** : In English we say **HYPHEN**

e.g.

alfonso\_barraza@itson.mx ...we say or read: alfonso **dot** barraza **at** itson **dot** mx

juan-hernandez\_24@hotmail.com...we say or read: juan **hyphen** hernandez

**underscore** twenty four **at** Hotmail **dot** com
